WHEREAS, November 6 is the hundredth anniversary of the birth of Henry Jan Paderewski, an admired a champion of liberty in the United States as in his native land of Poland; and,

WHEREAS, this servant of mankind has become cherished in the hearts and minds of all freedom loving people the world over for his magnificent dedication to the cause of peace and human justice; and,

WHEREAS, this great son of Poland has come to symbolize the traditional bond of Polish-American friendship forged in the unyielding adherence in which the memory of this great leader of the world is held by all Americans;

I, therefore, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November 6, 1960, as

AMERICAN-POLISH FRIENDSHIP DAY

in Minnesota.
