- WHEREAS, during the next decade a third of the young people entering the labor force will lack a high school diploma; and,
- WHEREAS, preparation for life and work requires an adequate education; and,
- WHEREAS, tomorrow's jobs will require higher skills to fill increasing demands for better trained scientists, engineers, office workers, teachers and craftsmen;

I, WALTER P. REEVE, I, Arville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, proclaim the month of September as

Stay in School Month

and urge the young people of Minnesota to return to school this fall and call upon parents, educators, management and labor to encourage youths to complete their education, thus helping them to realize their highest potential as citizens and workers.
