

A PROCLAMATION FOR "CONSTITUTIONAL WEEK"

WHEREAS, September 17, 1950, marks the one hundred twenty-third anniversary of the adoption of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention;

WHEREAS, the Constitution is the basis of our government and the guarantor of the rights of citizens in a democracy to our people;

WHEREAS, Public Law No. 215 provides for the issuance of a proclamation by the President of the United States designating September 17 through September 23 of each year as Constitution Week;

AND WHEREAS, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 17th through September 23rd, 1950 as

"CONSTITUTIONAL WEEK"

and urge all Minnesotans to give particular attention during that week to the Federal Constitution and the advantages of American citizenship which it secures.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this seventh day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred fifty and of the State the one hundred third.
