A PROCLAMATION FOR "STOUDEN DAY"

WHEREAS, General Friedrich Von Stouden, as Inspector General of the American Army under General George Washington, helped make possible our victorious struggle to establish an independent nation upon this continent; and,

WHEREAS, September 17th is the anniversary of the birthday of General Von Stouden; and,

WHEREAS, the Stouden Society of America, which includes Minnesota citizens, plans to pay tribute to the memory of General Von Stouden on the occasion of his birthday.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 17, 1960 as

"STOUDEN DAY"

In Minnesota and urge all citizens on this day to recognize the aid so rendered our country in its struggle for independence.
