

ORDINANCE NO. 89

VILLAGE OF FOLEY, BENTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE VILLAGE BOUNDARIES

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FOLEY, MINNESOTA, DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Village boundaries of the Village of
Foley are hereby extended so as to include the following described
parcels of land abutting upon said village, to-wit:

(A) Lots Seven (7) and Eight (8) in Block Five (5) of
Holdridge Addition to the Village of Foley, which is of record
in the name of Sylvester Mechavich.

(B) A rectangular tract of land in the South Half of the
Northwest Quarter ($S\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-five (25),
Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29), described
as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north right-of-way line of
State Trunk Highway No. 23 237.2 feet west of the point where
said north line of said highway intersects with the east line
of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$) of
said Section; thence north 225 feet; thence east 475.2 feet;
thence south 225 feet to the north line of said trunk highway;
thence west 475.2 feet to the point of beginning, which is of
record in the name of Olympic Lanes, Inc., a corporation.

Section 2. That the land above described in paragraph (A)
is platted and the land described in paragraph (B) is unplatted
and all of the land described above is less than 200 acres in
area and that all of the owners of the land have petitioned the
Village Council for annexing the said land to the Village, and
that the annexation of said land to the Village limits shall be
deemed complete upon the publication of said ordinance and the
filing of a certified copy thereof with the County Auditor, the
Secretary of State and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Passed at a regular meeting of the Village Council held on
the sixth day of September, 1960.
