WHEREAS, today, there is no known cure for this often fatal disease, which every year takes the lives of thousands of our youngsters; and,



NOW THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 12 - 19, 1960 as




in the State of Minnesota and call upon our people to observe the occasion in every appropriate way.
