ORDINANCE NO. 411 (S-2)
(Special)

An Ordinance Extending the Corporate Limits of the City of Willmar to Include Certain Unplatted Land Not Exceeding Two Hundred Acres, and to be known as "Washington School Second Addition."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WILLMAR AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A Petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Willmar, by the sole owner of the following described real estate to have such land included within the City of Willmar, Minnesota, as follows:

Part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty Two (22), Township One Hundred Nineteen (119), Range Thirty Five (35), West, described by metes and bounds as follows: Beginning at a point which said point is 627 feet south and 400 feet west of the Northeast corner of said Section; thence South and parallel with the East line of said Section a distance of 228.06 feet to a point; thence West and parallel with the North line of said Section a distance of 382 feet to a point; thence North and parallel with the East line of said Section a distance of 228.06 feet to a point; thence East and parallel with the North line of said Section a distance of 382 feet to the point or place of beginning.

SECTION 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is 2.00 acres.

SECTION 3. The City Council hereby makes the following determination, to-wit:

- 1) That the annexation will be to the best interest of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and of the territory affected.
- 2) That the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subject to City Government.

SECTION 4. Therefore the City of Willmar, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be, and the same is hereby, annexed to, and included in the City of Willmar, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

SECTION 5. That the said property henceforth be known as "WASHINGTON SCHOOL SECOND ADDITION" to the City of Willmar, Minnesota, when and if the same shall be platted.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in full force from and after filing a certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor of Kandiyohi County, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and from and after its passage and publication.
