WHEREAS, September 17, 1960, marks the one hundred seventy-third anniversary of the adoption of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and,

WHEREAS, the Constitution is the basis of our government and the guarantor of the rights of citizens in a democracy to our people; and,


WHEREAS, Public Law No. 215 provides for the issuance of a proclamation by the President of the United States designating September 17 through September 23 of each year as Constitution Week.

"CONSTITUTION WEEK"


and urge all Minnesotans to give particular attention during that week to the Federal Constitution and the advantages of American Citizenship which it accords.
