A PROCLAMATION FOR "REGISTER TO VOTE TIME"

WHEREAS, it is the duty, privilege, and responsibility of the American heritage of every citizen to register and to vote in each and all elections of their community on local, state and national issues; and,

WHEREAS, this is the last month in which you will be able to register to vote in the forthcoming general election.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of September 20 to October 18, 1960 as

"REGISTER TO VOTE TIME"

in Minnesota and call upon every Minnesota citizen to register to vote; and urge Voting Registration Centers, church organizations, every partisan and non-partisan organization, Mayors, City Councils, and other elected officials to make an all out effort to encourage all citizens to register to vote in their community.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twentieth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred sixty and of the State the one hundred third.
