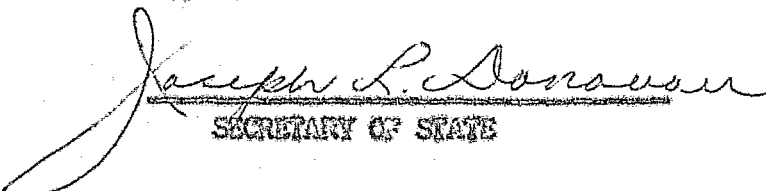
"PHARMACY WEEK"
