

ORDINANCE NO. 46

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF AVON, STEARNS COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the Village of Avon, Stearns County, Minnesota by the sole owners of the following described real estate to have such land included within the Village of Avon, Stearns County, Minnesota:

All that part of Government lot one (1) of Section Twenty-one (21) of Township One Hundred Twenty-five (125) North of Range Thirty (30) West, Stearns County, Minnesota, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the south line thereof, thirty-three (33) feet West of the Southeast corner thereof; thence due North One Hundred fifty-eight and 25/100 (158.25) feet; thence North 4°30' West, Eighty and 25/100 (80.25) feet; thence North 9°40' West Ninety-three and 11/100 (93.11) feet to the point of beginning of the tract herein described:
Thence North 17°40' West One Hundred ten (110) feet; thence South 52°16' West Eighty-one and 74/100 (81.74) feet; thence South 39°18' West Seventy-one and 6/100 (71.06) feet; thence North 88°50' East One Hundred Forty-two and 98/100 (142.98) feet to the place of beginning of said tract.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is less than one-half acre.

Section 3. The Village Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of Avon, Stearns County, Minnesota and of the territory affected, and that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

Section 4. The corporate limits of the Village are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1 and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. The Village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 6. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 5.
