PROCLAMATION

"PULASKI DAY"

WHEREAS, the Polish General Pulaski rendered great services to the American cause during the War for Independence against the British; and

WHEREAS, General Pulaski is held in great esteem by Americans for his valor;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Clevelie L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 11, 1960, as

PULASKI DAY

in Minnesota and do urge citizens of Minnesota to accord respect to General Pulaski as one of our great American heroes.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this Fourth day of October in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and sixty, and of the State the one hundred third.
