

A PROCLAMATION FOR "GRANDFATHERS' DAY"

WHEREAS, members of the National Federation of Grandfather Clubs of America have made outstanding contributions to life in their respective communities; and,

WHEREAS, the Federation with a membership of 20,000, has for the past twenty-one years observed the second Sunday in October as National Grandfathers' Day;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, October 9, 1960, as

"GRANDFATHERS' DAY"

in Minnesota and bring to the attention of the people of the State the contributions being made to our communities by grandfathers, and I urge all citizens, on that day, to join in tribute to these grand people who have obtained the happy state of grandfatherhood.
