EXECUTIVE ORDERS

17 October 1960

1. In accordance with provisions contained in Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 190.02, The Adjutant General will order to active duty elements of the Military Forces of the State of Minnesota as are required for the purpose of assisting the civil authorities of Goodhue County, Minnesota in connection with the visit of Dwight D. Eisenhower, President of the United States at Red Wing, Minnesota on 18 October 1960.

2. The cost of subsistence, transportation, pay and allowances of troops and other expenses involved will be defrayed from the general revenue of the State as provided by Minnesota Statutes 1957, Sections 192.49, 192.51 Subdivision 2, and 192.52.
