A PROCLAMATION FOR "NATIONAL FLOWER WEEK"

WHEREAS, on November 3, Minnesota florists will distribute as gifts to patients in the Veterans Hospital thousands of blossoms;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 23 through October 30 as

"NATIONAL FLOWER WEEK"

and invite our citizens to join these efforts to demonstrate the finer sentiments and pleasure flowers bring to our daily lives.
