

ORDINANCE NUMBER 12

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ANNEXATION OF ADJOINING TERRITORY.

The Village Council of the Village of East Bethel does ordain:

Whereas it is in the best interest of the Village of East Bethel and of the adjoining territory legally described as follows: Lots Eight (8), Thirteen (13), and Fifteen (15), Auditor's Sub-division One Twenty-Three (123); Township Thirty-Three (33), Range Twenty-Two (22), said territory is hereby annexed to the Village of East Bethel as petitioned by a majority of the owners of said property, effective upon the proper publication of this Ordinance.

Passed unanimously by the Council of the Village of East Bethel.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 15

An Ordinance extending the corporate limits of the Village of East Bethel to include certain unphatted land not exceeding two hundred acres.

Section 1 - A petition has been filed with the governing body of the Village of East Bethel, Minnesota by all of the owners in number of the following real estate to have such land included within the Village off East Bethel, Minnesota:

Lots 8 (Eight), 13 (Thirteen), and 15 (Fifteen), Auditor's Subdivision 123 (One Twenty-three) ,Range 22 (Twenty-two), Columbus Township.

The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is 1 3/4 acres.

Section 4. The Village Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of East Bethel, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village government.

Section 5. Therefore the Village of East Bethel, Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the Village of East Bethel, Minnesota as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
