To the Secretary of State and County Auditor of the County of Chisago:

I, Albert Amundson, clerk of the village of Taylors Falls, do hereby certify that at a special election held in the village on October 25, 1960, the following question was submitted to the voters of the village:

"Shall Optional Plan A, modifying the standard plan of village government by providing for the appointment by the council of the clerk, treasurer and assessor, be adopted for the government of the village?"

I further certify that the affirmative votes cast on the foregoing proposition were sixty-one, (61), and the negative votes were fourteen, (14), and the question of adoption of Optional Plan A received an affirmative majority of the votes cast on the question.
