In the Matter of the Petition to Distribute the Power to Appoint Managers of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District Among the Affected Counties (Section 112.42, Subd. 3)

FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, ORDER

A petition signed by the Ramsey County Board of Commissioners was filed with the Minnesota Water Resources Board on February 11, 1974, asking the Board to allocate to the Hennepin County Board of Commissioners, the authority to make the appointment to the Board of Managers of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District, of the manager which was previously appointed by Ramsey County.

The petition was heard on September 25, 1974, by Charles H. Prior, having been appointed by the Board to conduct the hearing, to take evidence in the matter, and to report to the Board. The hearing was held in the City Hall, 101 Elm Street, Savage, Minnesota, 55378. Mr. William Peterson was present representing the Board and the Attorney General; also present was Mr. Erling Weiberg, Executive Secretary for the Board; Mr. Raymond Haik, Attorney, Minneapolis, appeared for Lower Minnesota River Watershed District. The Board, upon the report of

the Referee and having fully considered the testimony and evidence offered at said hearing and all the files and records of the Board pertaining to said district, makes the following:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- I. Due and proper notice of the within hearing was given as provided by law, by mailed and published notice.
- II. The Lower Minnesota River Watershed District was established on March 23, 1960, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 112, and its territory is situated in parts of Carver, Dakota, Hennepin, Ramsey and Scott Counties; each of the Boards of County Commissioners of said counties has made one appointment of a manager to the Board of Managers of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District since its establishment.
- III. The Board did not and has not exercised its power to distribute the managers of said Watershed District among the said affected counties, prior to the within proceeding as authorized by Section 112.42, Subd. 3.
  - IV. A resolution of the Ramsey County Board of Commissioners requests the Water Resources Board to specifically assign the power of appointment of a manager of said Watershed District to a county board other than Ramsey County.
  - V. The Referee made a report, filed it with the Board, which accepted and approved the report.

- VI. The only part of Ramsey County in the said
  Watershed District is Pike Island, which lies
  in Fort Snelling State Park and the Ramsey
  County Board as a practice, has chosen a
  resident of Hennepin County as its appointee
  to the Watershed District Board of Managers.
- VII. That the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District extends over an area in Hennepin County from Fort Snelling to Carver County and includes part of the Cities of Bloomington and Eden Prairie.
- VIII. That the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District is engaged in cooperative projects with the said municipalities which have a large population.
  - IX. Of the affected counties, the area of the Watershed District in Hennepin County has a larger tax base, since 1971, than any of the other counties having territory in the Watershed District, and supplies the largest financial support to the administrative fund of the said Watershed District.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- X. The Minnesota Water Resources Board has jurisdiction over the matter of the distribution of managers of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District.
- XI. The public interest and public welfare will be served by a distribution of managers among said counties and that the distribution should be as follows:

One Manager from Carver County
One Manager from Dakota County
Two Managers from Hennepin County
One Manager from Scott County

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED

XII. The distribution of the power to appoint the managers of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District shall be and hereby is as follows:

Carver County - One Manager

Dakota County - One Manager

Hennepin County - Two Managers

Scott County - One Manager

- XIII. That upon expiration of the term of the manager of said Watershed District heretofore made by the Ramsey County Board of Commissioners on February 4, 1974, the appointment therefor shall be made by the Hennepin County Board of Commissioners of a resident of Hennepin County living within the territory of the Watershed District to the Board of Managers of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District.
- XIV. That the term of said manager shall be for a period of three years.
- XV. That the distribution of the power to appoint the managers of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District and the appointing Boards of County Commissioners are as stated in the following Table No. 1

FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, ORDER

A petition signed by the Managers of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District requesting a change of boundary in the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District by inclusion of certain land in the District, was filed with the Board on April 4, 1974.

The Board ordered a hearing on the petition and appointed C. H. Prior, a Board member, as Referee to conduct the hearing, to take evidence and report to the Board.

The hearing was held on September 25, 1974, at the City Hall, 101 Elm Street, Savage, Minnesota, 55378.

Mr. William Peterson, representing the Attorney General, and Mr. Erling Weiberg, Executive Secretary for the Board, appeared with Mr. Prior; Mr. Raymond Haik, Attorney, Minneapolis, appeared for the Managers of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District. Other interested persons were also present, including representatives of Nine Mile Creek and Riley-Purgatory Creek Watershed Districts.

The Referee having reported to the Board, and the Board having fully considered the testimony and evidence and all records and files of the Board pertaining to said District, now makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, Order:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- I. The Lower Minnesota River Watershed District was established by Order of the Minnesota Water Resources Board on March 23, 1960, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 112.
- TI. A duly signed petition by the Managers of said District asking for the inclusion of the land described in Paragraphs VI. A., B., and C., below, was filed with the Board on April 4, 1974, together with proper Affidavit of Service.
- III. The petition was sufficient and due and proper notice was given as prescribed by law, to all persons and parties affected.
- IV. The Director of the Division of Waters, Soils and Minerals filed his report herein and the Metropolitan Council filed its comments.
- V. The Referee made a report, filed it with the Board, which accepted and approved the report.
- VI. That all or parts of the following tracts of land are, in fact, a part of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District, and will receive benefits from the operation of said District; are contiguous thereto and can feasibly be administered by the Managers of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District. Said land is described as:

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- VII. The Minnesota Water Resources Board has jurisdiction of the within matter and proceeding.
- VIII. The public interest and welfare would be served by the addition of the above land to the territory of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District as set forth in Paragraph VI. above, bringing about changes in the existing boundary of said Watershed District.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED

- IX. That the boundary of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District be and hereby is changed at certain locations, by adding the property as described in Paragraph VI. above, to the territory of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District.
- X. The land affected by the aforesaid changes of boundary be and hereby are a part of and included in the territory of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District.
- XI. The boundary be and is hereby defined and fixed for the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District as follows:

Thence, from the northeast corner of the south half of Section 36, southerly on the boundary between the Cities of Eden Prairie and Bloomington on the east line of Section 36 to the southeast corner of Section 36, Township 116 North, Range 22 West; thence easterly in the City of Bloomington on the north line of Section 6, Township 115 North, Range 21 West, to the northeast corner of Section 6, Township 115 North, Range 21 West; thence northerly on the west line of Section 32, Township 116 North, Range 21 West, to the northwest corner of the south half of Section 32;

FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

A petition having been heretofore filed with the Minnesota Water Resources Board request that the boundaries of the above district as originally ordered be redefined and changed pursuant to the provisions of Laws of 1955, Chapter 799, as amended; and

The Board having ordered that a hearing be held on said petition on the 25th day of October, 1960 at 10:00 A.M. in the First National Bank Building, Shakopee, Minnesota, and the Board having held said hearing pursuant to said order on October 25, 1960; and

Virgil C. Herrick, Attorney and Executive Secretary of the Minnesota Water Resources Board, having appeared for the Board; Raymond A. Haik having appeared for the Lower Minnesota River Water-shed District and Dean K. Johnson having appeared for the Upper Mississippi Waterway Association, Inc.; and

The Board, having examined the petition, testimony and evidence, offered and received on behalf of the petitioners, no objectors being present, and having duly considered the same, and having considered all the records and files of the Board relating to said petition now makes the following FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

T

That the above district lies wholly within the petitioning counties and that a duly executed petition of the counties of Carver, Dakota, Hennepin, Ramsey and Scott was filed with the Board on August 20, 1960. Attached to said petition were proof of service upon the Director of the Division of Waters, the Commissioner of Conservation and the auditors of Carver, Dakota, Hennepin, Ramsey and Scott counties. Also attached was a map showing the proposed boundary.

II

That said petition was found sufficient by the Board and that a hearing thereon was ordered to be held on October 25, 1960 at 10:00 A.M. in the basement of the First National Bank Building, Shakopee, Minnesota. Notice of this hearing was given by publication in a regular newspaper in Carver, Dakota, Hennepin, Ramsey and Scott counties as required by statute, and in addition thereto, notice was mailed to the Commissioner of Conservation, the Director of the Division of Waters, County Auditor of each of the above counties, and the chief executive official of the affected municipalities; and

III

That the Director of the Division of Waters examined the petition and filed his report with the Board. This report recommended certain changes in the terminology describing a boundary. This report was read and received in evidence at the hearing; and

IV

That the duly qualified managers of the above district desire

to establish an organizational and administrative expense fund as authorized by the Minnesota Watershed Ast as amended. In order to establish this fund, it is necessary to levy a property tax on the property within the district. The description of the lands originally used in defining the district when it was organized is not of sufficient detail to enable the county auditors to levy a property tax; and

Upon the foregoing Finds of Fact, the BOARD CONCLUDES AND ORDERS:

V

That the Board has jurisdiction and authority to order the change and boundaries of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District.

VI

That the purpose in petitioning for the change in boundaries is to enable the managers of the watershed district to establish an organizational and administrative expense fund, as authorized
by the Minnesota Watershed Act. That the description used in defining the boundary in the order establishing the district was not in
sufficient detail to enable the county auditors to levy a property
tax. That it is the conclusion of the Board that the above described
purpose is legitimate and reasonable;

VII

That the Board, its employees and advisors have carefully examined the petition and compared the description with maps and plats on file; that based on the testimony and other evidence the following described boundary appears to be sufficient to enable the managers to accomplish the purposes of the district, and enable the taxing authorities to levy a property tax for any authorized purpose.

The Board, in adopting the description, has incorporated suggested revisions made by the Division of Waters, Department of Conservation.

#### VIII

That the Board hereby orders that the following boundary be and hereby is established as the official boundary of the Lower Minnesota River Watershed District.
