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ORDINANCE # 14

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF LA SALLE TO  
INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS NOT EXCEEDING TWO ACRES.

At a regular meeting of the Village Council of La Salle Village held  
at the Council Chambers on September 14, 1960, Ewald Noren introduced  
and read the following resolution and moved its adoption:

Section I. Whereas, a petition has been filed with the governing body  
of La Salle, Minnesota asking that the following described real estate be  
included within the Village of La Salle, Minnesota:

Commencing at a point 345 feet south and 17 feet northwest of the  
intersection of the east section line of section 17, township 107 north,  
range 31 west and the center line of the Minneapolis & St. Louis R. R.,  
and which said intersection is 1497 feet south of the northeast corner of  
the southeast quarter of said section 17; thence northwest and at right  
angles to the center line of said Minneapolis & St. Louis R. R. for a  
distance of 233 feet; thence northeast and parallel to the said center line  
of the said Minneapolis & St. Louis R. R. for a distance of 284 feet; thence  
southeast and at right angles to the said center line of said Minneapolis &  
St. Louis R. R. for a distance of 100 feet; thence northeast and parallel to  
the said center line of said Minneapolis & St. Louis R. R. for a distance of  
296 feet; thence at this point sight back and turn angle to the left of 24  
degrees and 31 minutes for a distance of 223 feet to a point that is 8.5  
feet northwest and at right angles to the center line of the Minneapolis &  
St. Louis R. R. house track; thence southwest and parallel to the said  
Minneapolis & St. Louis R. R. house track for a distance of 381 feet to the  
point of commencing.

Section II. The Village Council hereby determines:

1. That the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village  
of La Salle, Minnesota and of the territory affected.
2. That the territory described herein abuts upon the Village of  
La Salle, Minnesota and is so conditioned as properly to be subject to  
village government.

Section III. That the quantity of land within the foregoing descrip-  
tion as described is 1.967 plus acres.

Section IV. The corporate limits of the Village of La Salle are  
hereby extended to include the property described in Section I and the same  
is hereby included and annexed as effectively as if it had been a part thereof.

Section V. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified  
copy of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipalities Commission, the  
County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

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Section VI. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section V.

The motion was seconded by Holmquist and thereupon the following vote was had: Ayes: Four. Nays: None.
