SIMULTANEOUS DETACHMENT AND ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN
PROPERTY UNDER CHAPTER 686, MINNESOTA LAWS 1959,
SECTION 6.

O R D E R

The Village of Little Canada has, by resolution of the Village Council at a regular meeting held on October 12, 1960, petitioned for the detachment of certain property hereinafter described, and the Village of Maplewood has, at a regular meeting of the Village Council held on November 3, 1960, petitioned to annex the same territory, pursuant to Chapter 686, Minnesota Laws 1959, Section 6.

The territory involved consists of:

All that part of the Village of Little Canada contained within the area bounded on the north by the south right-of-way line of Highway 36, on the east by the center line of Edgerton Street, on the south by the center line of County Road B and on the west by the center line of McMenemy Street extended to the south right-of-way line of Highway 36.

All of the requirements of the statute having been met,

IT IS ORDERED: That the above described real property be, and hereby is, detached from the Village of Little Canada and annexed to the Village of Maplewood, the same as if it had originally been a part thereof.
