CHAPTER NO. 293

AN ORDINANCE VACATING LINCOLN PARKWAY, A/K/A LINCOLN AVENUE

WHEREAS the owners of lands abutting upon Lincoln Parkway, also known as Lincoln Avenue, lying between 3rd Street and 4th Street of the City of Montevideo, have petitioned the City Council to have said tract of land vacated and forever discharged from any dedication thereof to public use, and

WHEREAS the aforesaid Lincoln Parkway, also known as Lincoln Avenue, has never been open to public travel as a street or other public thoroughfare and because of its location and the use of abutting properties is not suitable for public travel or public use,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Montevideo does ordain as follows:

Section 1.

That Lincoln Parkway, also known as Lincoln Avenue, lying between 3rd Street and 4th Street in the City of Montevideo, be and the same hereby is vacated and forever released and discharged from any dedication thereof to public use.

Section 2.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication as by the charter provided.
