



ORDINANCE NO. 413
(Special)

An Ordinance Extending the Corporate Limits of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, to Include Certain Land Not Exceeding Two Hundred Acres. (Described as Lots 10, 11 and part of Lots 12 and 13 and also Lots 6 and 7 of Leary's Addition, all in Sub-Division of N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 22, T. 119, R. 35).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WILLMAR AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Petitions have been filed with the governing body of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, by the sole owners, and all thereof, of the herein described real estate, to have such land included within the limits of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, as follows:

Lots Ten, Eleven, Twelve and Thirteen (10, 11, 12 and 13), (except the Easterly One Hundred Fifty Two Feet (152) of said Lots Twelve and Thirteen (12 and 13), of Subdivision of part of the North Half of the Northeast Quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty Two (22), Township One Hundred Nineteen (119), Range Thirty Five (35); also Lots Six and Seven (6 and 7) in Leary's Addition (also a Subdivision of part of the North Half of the Northeast Quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty Two (22), Township One Hundred Nineteen (119), Range Thirty Five (35), all in Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, and according to the recorded plat thereof now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Kandiyohi County, Minnesota.

SECTION 2. The quantity of land embraced within the above description and bounded as described is 2.4 acres.

SECTION 3. The City Council hereby determines:

1. That the annexation will be to the best interest of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and of the territory affected;
2. That the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City Government.

SECTION 4. WHEREFORE, the City of Willmar hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinabove described be, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City of Willmar, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof. (The Easterly One Hundred Fifty Two (152) feet of said Lot Twelve and said Lot Thirteen, further above described, was duly annexed to the City by the terms of Ordinance No. 367, adopted by the City Council on November 26, 1951.)

An Ordinance Relating to the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and providing for the annexation of certain real estate, described as Lots 10, 11 & 12 of Block 12, and Lots 10, 11 & 12 of Block 13, of the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 22, Township One Hundred Nineteen (119), Range Thirty Five (35), all in Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, as shown on the plat thereof now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Kandiyohi County, Minnesota.

SECTION 1. Petitions have been filed with the City Council of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, by the sole owners and occupants of the herein described real estate, to have such lands included within the limits of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, as follows:

Lots Ten, Eleven, Twelve and Thirteen (10, 11, 12 and 13), (except the Easterly One Hundred Fifty Two feet (152) of said Lots Twelve and Thirteen (12 and 13)), of Subdivision of part of the North Half of the Northeast Quarter (N 1/2 of NE 1/4) of Section Twenty Two (22), Township One Hundred Nineteen (119), Range Thirty Five (35); also Lots Six and Seven (6 & 7) in Block 12, also a Subdivision of part of the North Half of the Northeast Quarter (N 1/2 of NE 1/4) of Section Twenty Two (22), Township One Hundred Nineteen (119), Range Thirty Five (35), all in Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, and according to the recorded plat thereof now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Kandiyohi County, Minnesota.

SECTION 2. The quantity of land embraced within the above description and bounded as described is 2.4 acres.

SECTION 3. The City Council hereby determines:

1. That the annexation will be in the best interest of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and of the territory affected.
2. That the territory described herein shall upon the City and is so conditioned as property to be subjected to City Government.

SECTION 4. WHEREFORE, the City of Willmar hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be, and the same be hereby annexed to, and included in the City of Willmar, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had

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originally been a part thereof. (The Eastern Wisconsin City and Village Code of said lot Twelve and said lot thirteen, further been described, was first annexed to the City by the terms of Ordinance No. 307, adopted by the City Council on November 25, 1951.)

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be read and published in three places and after first publication shall be read by the Municipal Commission, and then by a public hearing in the City, Minnesota, and the Secretary of State of Minnesota, and then and after its publication.
