ORDINANCE # 7/ AN OPDINANCE EXTERDING THE CORPORATE LIMIT OF THE VILLAGE OF MORNOGO TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNFLATTED LAND NOT EXCEPTING 200 ACRES.

Section 1. = A petition has been filed with the governing body of the Village of Norwood, Minnesota, by Jacob Bentz and Lillegul Bentz, husband and wife, the sole owners of the following described real estate to have such lands included within the Village of horwood, Finnerota:

> Commencing at a point which point is 33 feet South, thence 342.85 feet E st of the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 14, Township 115 Mange 26; thence running South 65 feet; thence Best 75 feet; thence North 65 feet; thence West 75 feet to the place of beginning. containing. .112 acre, more or less.

Situated in Lot 1 of Section 14, Township 115 Range 26.

Section 2. = The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is .112 acre.

Section 3. = The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the test interest of the Village of Norwood, Minnesota and of the territory affected.
