

ORDER

WHEREAS, The Honorable D. E. LaBelle, Judge of the District Court of the Fourth Judicial District, Minnesota, has filed with the undersigned Governor of Minnesota his application for retirement pursuant to the authority of Minnesota Statutes 1957, sections 490.101 to 490.104 as amended; that he is past 73 years of age, having served as a judge of a court of record and as such judge for a period of more than 15 years; that by such application he prays the order of the Governor of Minnesota directing his retirement, effective December 31, 1960; and it appearing that he is entitled to that retirement under the law;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, in pursuance of the law aforesaid, do hereby order and direct the retirement of D. E. LaBelle aforesaid as Judge of the District Court of the Fourth Judicial District, Minnesota, pursuant to the authority of Minnesota Statutes 1957, sections 490.101 to 490.104 as amended, thereby entitling him to retirement pay to be paid at the time and in the manner provided by law and I direct that this order be filed in the office of the Secretary of State of Minnesota, and that this Executive Order shall take effect at midnight, December 31, 1960.
