The ballots and election supplies shall be provided by the petitioners.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the petitioners cause a copy of this Order approving the petition for annexation to be posted not less than 20 days before the 23rd day of August, 1960, in three public places in the area proposed

for annexation, and to be published in the Albert Lea Tribune a medium of official and legal publication of general circulation in the area proposed for annexation, two weeks before the 23rd day of August, 1960.

WHEREAS the City Council does verily believe, that certain properties contained within the following described boundaries:

Beginning at the center of Section 9, Township 102, Range 21 West; thence South on the West line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 9 to the South quarter corner of Section 9; thence East on the South line of Section 9 to the Southeast corner of Section 9; thence North on the East line of Section 9 to the South right-of-way line of the C.M. St. P. & P.R.R.; thence East on the South right-of-way of the C.M. St. P. & R.R.R. to the East line of Morningside Addition; thence North on the East line of Morningside Addition to the North right-of-way line of S.E. Marshall St.; thence West on the North right-of-way line of S.E. are adjacent to and abut on the corporate limits of the City of Albert and are so conditioned so as to properly be annexed to the City of Albert Lea;

NOW THEREFORE the City Council does hereby petition the Municipal Annexation Commission as permitted by Laws 1959, Chapter 686 (Minnesota Statutes, Section Lilk.Ol et seq.) for the annexation of said area to the City of Albert Lea.

BE IT RESOLVED that City Council does make certain findings in accordance with the procedural requirements of Laws 1959, Chapter 686, Section 3, which are as follows:

### RESOLUTION NO. 143 CONTINUED

1. The proposed area to be annexed contains 226 acres of which approximately 88 acres is Albert Lea Lake bottom and is included in the description only to join with an existing part of Albert Lea Lake within the City making a reasonable City Limits boundary.

The area contains 636 persons residing therein of which approximately 358 are adults.

3. The Area is primarily residential with some vacant and undeveloped properties; a few commercial and service businesses and a major industry

consisting of the meat packing plant of Wilson & Co. 4. The area is very mixed in character and has developed without zoning, subdivision controls or planning. Many of the buildings are substandard

and interspersed with other residences.

The area is served by private septic tanks and cess pools and private wells except that Wilson & Co. is in the process of building their own sewage disposal plant. There are many instances of improper sowage disposal, surface leaching from septic tanks and septic overflow to the lake.

There is no storm drainage in the area and considerable washing of gravel

streets and ponding of water.

7. The area is now zoned by Albert Lea Township under an ordinance passed in 1958.

8. There is no comprehensive street planning in the area and many of the streets dead end or building has been done where there are no platted streets. Some of the area is small lots of metes & bonds descriptions.

Mire protection is inadequate by the township and many fire hazards exist.

- Recently a small quouset bldg. with one entrance burned with loss of life. 10. Police protection is furnished by the County Sherriff only. During the recent Wilson strike the City furnished a major proportion of the local police protection even though the plant is outside the City. The township furnished no police whatsoever.
- 11. The City Council has caused a census to be taken of the area and has prepared topographic maps of the area for sewer and water service planning.

NOW RE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Albert Lea that this petition, together with the census taken be transmitted to the Municipal Commission for further proceedings and annexation of the area in the manner provided by law.

HE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that publication of this Resolution be dispensed with under the provisions of Sec. 21 of the Charter of the City of Albert  $L_{\rm e}a$ .

#### MEMORANDUM OPINION

The Minnesota Municipal Commission has considered in great detail the motions of Wilson & Co., Inc. The motions relating to amendment, vacation and addition to the Findings of Fact involve proposale that are inconsistent with the Findings of the Commission as supported by the entire record, or not inconsistent but superfluous and immeterial or involve Conclusions of Law which the Commission has already decided upon the entire record. As to the motions relating to the amendment of the Conclusions of Law and Order of the Commission, the Municipal Commission has already ruled on most of the other objections by Wilson & Co., Inc. As to the examination of ballots, the Municipal Commission Law provides in Section 3, subdivision & that the election shall be conducted so far as practicable "in accordance with the laws regulating the election of town officers." The said election Laws 1957, Chapter 675, relating to town elections, in Article II, Section 6 (M.S.A. 205.06, subdivision 3) provide for contested elections. In Laws 1959, Chapter 675, Article X there is provision for questioning the declared result upon "other questions submitted by popular vote," (M.S.A. 209.08). Said provision for examination of ballots is restricted to action by the District Court upon complaint "within ten days after the canvass is completed," (M.S.A. 209.08; 209.09). The Commission Law, Section 3, subdivision 4, limits the persons who may participate in the election to "Only the voters residing within the territory described in the Commission's Order." If the only persons entitled to participate in the election are foreclosed by Law from contesting the same, it does not seem that Wilson & Co., Inc., non-voter, should have greater rights. Unless such greater rights are provided by Statute, they cannot be recognized by the Commission. As to the stay of the Commission's Order to March 1, 1961, the Court, of course, can extend the stay to the extent that it deems proper.
