WHEREAS, the supervisors of the South Goodhue Soil Conservation District on the 4th day of August, 1960, and the supervisors of the North Goodhue Soil Conservation District on the 7th day of November, 1960, did adopt a resolution requesting that said soil conservation districts, which description is made a part hereof as fully as if set forth herein verbatin as given in the statements by the State Soil Conservation Committee for each of the two above named districts, be consolidated into one district to be known as the Goodhue County Soil and Water Conservation District, and

WHEREAS, the State Soil Conservation Committee, on the 19th day of December, 1960, pursuant to power and authority vested in this committee by law, by resolution granted the consolidation of said districts into one soil conservation district to be known as the GOODHUE COUNTY SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, and

WHEREAS, copies of said resolutions have been made and filed in this office as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby certified that the territory described in said Resolution has been duly consolidated into one district known as the GOODNUE COUNTY SOIL AND SATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT.
