WHEREAS, the physical, educational, and social activities of the Campfire Girls contribute materially to the development of good health, useful lives, and responsible citizens of its members,

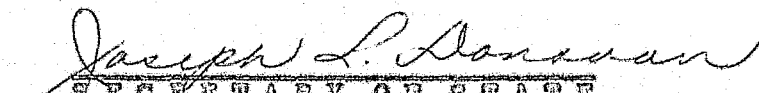
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 21 through January 26, as

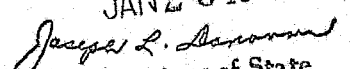
"CAMPFIRE GIRLS JUBILEE WEEK"
