The Common Council of the City of Morshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesote by the sole owners of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesota:

> Beginning at the northwest corner of Section Ten (10), Township One Hundred Eleven (111) North, of Hange Forty-one (kl), West of the Fifth Principal Meridian; thence east thirty-three (33) foot; thence south and parallel to the west line of said Section Ten (10) to the extension of the south and cost line of E Street of the City of Morshall; thence in a southwesterly direction along said extension of the south and cost line of said E Street to the west line of soid Section Ton (10); thence north along said west line of soid Section Ten (10) to the point of beginning:
