

PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

To the Village Council of the Village of Wolf Lake, Minnesota:

The undersigned, sole owner, of the territory hereinafter described, hereby requests the council to annex said territory to the village and to extend the village boundaries to include the same, and for that purpose respectfully states:

1. The territory to be annexed consists of land which have been platted into lots and blocks, which plats have been duly and legally made and certified according to the laws of this State and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of Becker county, Minnesota and partly of unplatted land which do not exceed 800 acres in area. All of said land, both platted and unplatted, lie entirely within the County of Becker, Minnesota, and the description of said land, both platted and unplatted, is as follows:

"Commencing in the Southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 33, Township 137 North, Range 37 East of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Becker County, Minnesota, and running nine hundred twelve feet (912) North along section line to point of beginning, thence two hundred (200) feet East; thence one hundred (100) feet North; thence two hundred (200) feet East; thence one hundred (100) feet South to point of beginning."

The herein described tract is subject to an easement for Public Road purposes along its East boundary.

2. The territory described above abuts upon the village limits and none of it is presently a part of any incorporated city, village, or borough, except the Village of Wolf Lake.

3. All of said territory is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

Therefore: The undersigned owner of the above described land abutting the incorporated village of Wolf Lake, hereby petitions the Village of Wolf Lake to have said property annexed to the Village of Wolf Lake and to become a part of the Village of Wolf Lake.

ORDINANCE 14

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF WOLF LAKE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PLANTED AND UNPLANTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated October 11, 1950, requesting annexation of the territory described below was duly presented to the council on the 11 day of October 1950.

The Council of the Village of Wolf Lake ordains:

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows:

"Commencing in the Southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 35, Township 139 North, Range 37 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Becker County, Minnesota, and running nine hundred twelve feet (912) North along section line to point of beginning, thence; two hundred (200) feet West; thence one hundred (100) feet North; thence two hundred (200) feet East; thence one hundred (100) feet South to point of beginning."

The herein described tract is subject to an easement for Public Road purposes along its East boundary.

Section 3. Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance in the office of the secretary of State and in the office of the county auditor of Becker County.

Section 4. Effective Date of Annexation. Annexation shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this ordinance have been filed as directed in section 3.
