

ORDINANCE

The Village of Appleton do ordain as follows:

14.6 Whereas all the owners of the following described real estate having petitioned the Village Council, praying that said tract which abuts the corporate limits of the Village of Appleton, be annexed to and become a part of said Village and Village Council having determined that it will be to the best interests of the Village and the territory affected, and it further appearing that said area is unplatted and does not exceed 200 acres, now, therefore:

The Village of Appleton do ordain that the following described parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Swift State of Minnesota and abutting the incorporated limits of the Village of Appleton, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the east line of Bordson Avenue that is 30 feet south of the Southwest corner of Shelstad's First Addition in the Village of Appleton, Minnesota; thence east on a line that is parallel with the south line of said Shelstad's first addition, 356 feet; Thence South 162 feet; Thence West, on a line that is parallel with the South line of said Shelstad's First Addition, 356.5 feet to the east line of Bordson Avenue; ; Thence north along the east line of Bordson Avenue 162 feet to the point of beginning, be and hereby is Annexed to the Village of Appleton, Minnesota.

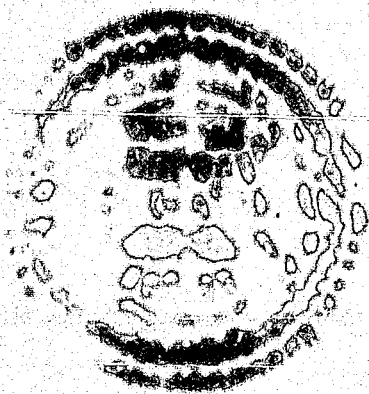
