


Dear Sir:

ORDINANCE NO. 45

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE DATE OF THE  
REGULAR VILLAGE ELECTION OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERTOWN

WHEREAS, the regular village election of the Village of Watertown,  
County of Carver, State of Minnesota, is held annually on the first  
Tuesday after the first Monday in December every year; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes Section 205.07 provides that the  
governing body of every village may, by ordinance passed at a regular  
meeting held before September 1, elect to hold the election on the first  
Tuesday after the first Monday in November;

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERTOWN, CARVER COUNTY,  
MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Change of Date of Election. The date on which the  
regular village election of the Village of Watertown is hereby changed  
from the first Tuesday after the first Monday in December every year to  
the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November every year.

Section 2. Notice. The village clerk is hereby directed to give  
written notice in writing to the County Auditor, Carver County, Minnesota,  
and to the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

Section 3. Effective Date of Ordinance. This ordinance shall be  
deemed effective upon the giving of written notice as directed in Section  
2 above.
