

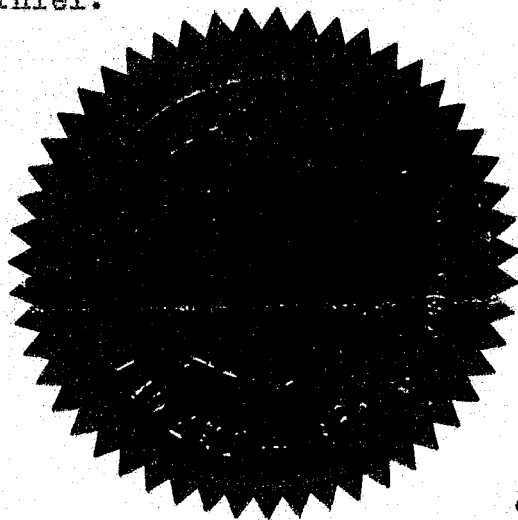
STATE OF MINNESOTA,

WHEREAS, Charles Dillehay was on or about the 22nd day of September, 1915, murdered in the County of Nobles in the State of Minnesota; and,

WHEREAS, The murderers of the said Charles Dillehay have not been apprehended and the public welfare requires their capture, conviction, and punishment for said offense; and,

WHEREAS, There is reason to believe that one Jesse Thiel is guilty of the murder of the said Charles Dillehay;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Winfield S. Hammond, Governor of the State of Minnesota, will cause to be paid out of the Treasury of the State the sum of TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) for the arrest and conviction or for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the said Jesse Thiel.
