WHEREAS, the highways, our wooded areas, lakes and hills are a source of pleasure to residents and tourists alike, and



NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the year 1961 as


"DON'T BE A LITTERING YEAR"
