A PROCLAMATION FOR CHILDREN AND FOR YOUTH ALIYAH

WHEREAS, people of all faiths have always expressed a deep concern for the oppressed people of the world, as well as those fleeing from persecution, and

WHEREAS, the child rescue and immigration movement, Youth Aliyah, has rescued and brought to Israel more than 100,000 Jewish children, actual and potential victims of physical, spiritual and economic persecution, and

WHEREAS, within our State the various of B'nai B'rith, the Women's Zionist Organization of America—the official American representative of Youth Aliyah—our community to provide the means for the rescue of more Jewish children for a chance for a new life in Israel,

THAT, **THEODORE F.**, Oliver L. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 17, 1961, as

"CHILDREN'S DAY FOR YOUTH ALIYAH"

in Minnesota and urge all persons to join with B'nai B'rith and other groups in this historic endeavor.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this tenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one and of the State, the one hundred third.
