A PROCLAMATION FOR STUDENT GOVERNMENT WEEK

WHEREAS, it is well to encourage the youth of our state to take an active interest, not only in the government of their own affairs, but those of the state and nation as well, and

WHEREAS, the local association of Young Leaders Student Government has undertaken sponsorship of a state-wide conference to better coordinate the work of these organizations and to increase the interest and participation in the affairs of student government by all our young people,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 7 through May 13, 1951, as

STUDENT GOVERNMENT WEEK

In Minnesota and urge all citizens to encourage and support the activities of our student government groups so that we may all play a part in furthering the good citizenship these organizations will toward better understanding of the complexities and functions of local, state and national government.
