AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LEMITS & 20 CORPORATE L

Section 1. =

A petition has been filed with the Governing body of the Village of Young America, Einnesota, by Richard L. Tollers and Alice Tellers, his wife the sole owners of the following described real estate, to have such land included within the Village of Young America, Minnesota:

The North half of the following described piece of land, to-wit: Commanding at the Southwest corner of Conrac Wiedeneder's land and running a line 1.97 chains 15° Sortheast, to a post, where the following described tract commences and runs 5.00 chains 66° Northwest; thence 4.00 chains 38° Southwest; thence 5.00 chains 66° Southcast; thence 4 chains 38° Northwest to starting point, the above described land being a part of Nest one half of Southcast Quarter, Section 11, Township 115 North of Mange 26 Nest, excepting therefrom: Commencing at a point of which the center quarter Section post of Section 11, Township 115 Range 26, beers North 15.90 chains and West 20 chains; thence South 0.75 chains; thence North 47° Nest 6.30 chains; thence run 1.97 chains 15° Northwest to a post, being the Northwest corner of Mary Schmeewind's land; thence running 5 chains 66° Northwest;
