WHEREAS, civic projects, local, regional and national charitable programs plus countless other events are consistently granted the unselfish support of our radio stations, and

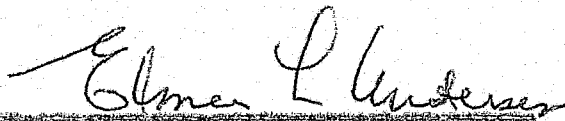

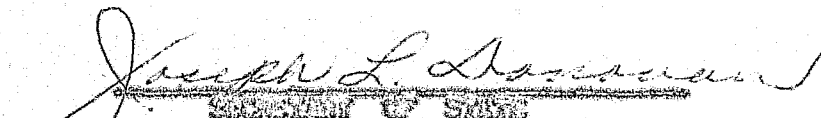
I, ELMER L. ANDERSON, I, Elmer L. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the month of May as

NATIONAL RADIO MONTH

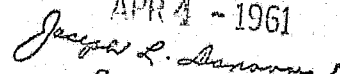
in Minnesota and urge all citizens to take note of the achievements of the radio broadcasting industry and its personnel throughout our State and the entire country.
