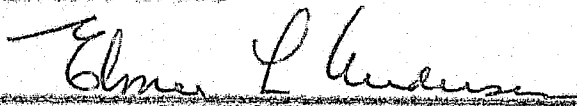
WHEREAS, the Minnesota Business Association has volunteered its services and facilities to the end that a maximum number of people of our state may pledge to always drive safely,

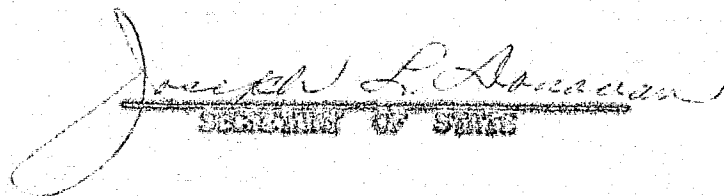
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May, 1961, as

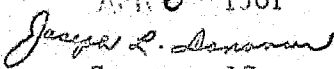
"SAFE DRIVING PLEDGE MONTH"
