WHEREAS, public support of the program of the Multiple Sclerosis chapter is essential to the welfare of those citizens who are crippled or rendered helpless by multiple sclerosis,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the first two weeks of May as

in the State of Minnesota and urge all citizens of our State to support the 1961 campaign of the Multiple Sclerosis chapter.
