A PROCLAMATION FOR "REALTOR WEEK"

WHEREAS, Realtors, in serving both buyers and sellers of real property, are pledged to conduct all business in conformity with their lofty Code of Ethics; and

WHEREAS, Realtors have taken the lead in solving real estate problems arising from blight and slums through the activities of their national Build America Better Program which gives expert advice to our communities on urban renewal;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of April 23 through April 29, 1961, as
