Mayer Village Ordinance
No. 32

An ordinance extending the corporate limits of the Village of Mayer to include certain platted or unplatted land not exceeding 200 acres in area:

Whereas, a certain petition dated Oct. 10, 1960, requesting annexation of the territory described below was duly presented to the council on the 10th day of Oct. 1960:

The Village Council of the Village of Mayer Ordains:

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows:

Beginning at the Quarter corner on the North and South section line between Section 1-116-26 and Section 6-116-23; and running North along said Section line a distance of 1245 feet to a point; said point being the place of beginning of this description; thence deflecting right 90 degrees and running East a distance of 203 feet to a point; thence deflecting right at an angle of 90 degrees and running South along a line parallel to aforesaid Section line a distance of 140 feet to a point; thence deflecting right at an angle of 90 degrees and running West a distance of 203 feet to a point; thence deflecting right at an angle of 90 degrees and running North along said Section line a distance of 140 feet to place of beginning; the tract thus described being in Waconia Township and located on the Northern outskirts of the Village of MAYER, Carver County, Minnesota.

Section 3. Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance in the office of the secretary of state and in the office of the county auditor of Carver County.

Section 4. Effective Date of Annexation. Annexation shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this ordinance have been filed as directed in section 3. The above petition was signed by all the owners of the property affected.
