ORDINANCE # 39
AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE BOUNDARIES OF
THE VILLAGE OF HAMBURG, MINNESOTA AND IN-
CORPORATE ADDITIONAL TERRITORY THEREIN

Section 1. = The Village of Hamburg, Minnesota is the owner of the following described premises situate in carver county, Minnesota,

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of Louisa Street extended and the North line of Sofia Street, in the Village of Hamburg; thence North $36^{\circ}09'$ East along the center line of Louisa Street extended 447.00 feet; thence North $78^{\circ}46'$ West, 480 feet; thence due South and parallel to the West line of Section 28 Township 115 North Range 26 West, 385.08 feet, plus or minus, to the North line of Sofia Street; thence Easterly along the North line of Sofia Street to the point of beginning.

For the purpose of the foregoing description the bearing of the West line of Section 28 has been assumed to be due North and South.

Section 2. = That said premises are not within the present corporate limits of the Village and the Village Council hereby determines that the annexation of said territory will be to the best interest of the Village and of the Territory affected.

Section 3. = That the territory described herein abutts upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village Government.

Section 4. = Therefore the Village of Hamburg, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the Village of Hamburg, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. = This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing a certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
