ORDINANCE # 40

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE VILLAGE OF HANBURG TO INCLUDE CERTAIN
UNPLATED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES.

Section 1. e A petition has been filed with the Governing body of the Village of Hanburg, Minn., by the sole owners of the following described real estate to have such land included within the Village of Hanburg, Minnesota:

Commencing at a point 16 rods North from the Southeast corner of Section 29; thence running North along said Section line between Sections 29 and 30, 6 rods to a point; thence West parallel with Section line between Sections 29 and 32, 10 rods to a point; thence South 4 rods to a point; thence East parallel with Section line between Sections 29 and 32, 10 rods to point of beginning, being one-fourth of an acre of land situate in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of section 29, Township 115 North of Range 26 West.

Section 2. e The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded as described is one-fourth acre.

Section 3. e The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the Village of Hanburg, Minn., and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village Government.

Section 4. e Therefore, the Village of Hanburg, Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the Village of Hanburg, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. e This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing a certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
