A PROCLAMATION FOR VACATION PLANNING WEEK

- WHEREAS, all citizens of the United States depend on their vacations for pleasure, rest, relaxation and better health, and
- WHEREAS, thousands of men and women in the State of Minnesota depend, directly or indirectly, on tourist trade to provide them with gainful employment, and
- WHEREAS, traveling vacationers contribute millions of dollars in gasoline and other taxes to the State Treasury of Minnesota, and
- WHEREAS, individuals, companies and industries catering to vacationers are vitally important to the progress and prosperity of our State, and
- WHEREAS, the vacation travel industry of America has announced that the period May 21 through May 27, 1961, will be observed throughout the United States as "Vacation Planning Week" with the purpose of enabling all Americans to take fullest advantage of their holidays, and
- WHEREAS, all residents of Minnesota are proud of the beauty spots which abound in this state and are anxious to attract visitors from all parts of the nation,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period May 21 through May 27, 1961, as

"VACATION PLANNING WEEK"

in the State of Minnesota and urge all individuals, companies, industries and other organizations to give the observance their fullest cooperation and support.
