

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the employees of the State of Minnesota recognize the value of regular donations of blood to be used in connection with the preservation of human life, and

WHEREAS, the St. Paul Regional Blood Center, which is affiliated with the American National Red Cross, is scheduled to collect contributions of blood in the State Capitol area on Friday, June 9, 1961, and

WHEREAS, the practice of regular donating of blood contributes materially to the welfare of the employees, their families and the community,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, June 9, 1961, as State Employees Blood Donation Day and urge all Capitol area employees to participate in this very worthy project.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one and of the State, the one hundred third.
