A PROCLAMATION FOR "AMERICAN WOOL MONTH"

- WHEREAS, September has been designated as American Wool Month, the purpose of which is to promote a fuller appreciation of American wool and American-made wool products; and
- WHEREAS, wool is one of our country's important agricultural commodities and is so essential to the national economy inasmuch as it is in national defense; and
- WHEREAS, the production of American wool products is of concern to thousands of individuals whose well-being is indirectly or directly dependent upon the American wool industry; and
- WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota is proud to be numbered among the important wool producing and wool manufacturing states;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of September, 1961, as

"AMERICAN WOOL MONTH"

and urge all of our citizens to participate in the salute to American wool and American wool products.
