A PROCLAMATION FOR "SAFE BUNTING WEEK"

- WHEREAS, increasing numbers of our citizens are participating in hunting for health and recreation, and
- WHEREAS, this increase in recreational hunting has greatly increased the use of our waterways and has intensified the need for close adherence to accepted safe-hunting practices to prevent loss of life and damage to property, and
- WHEREAS, continued cooperation among persons and organizations interested in hunting is necessary to maintain our steady progress towards the ultimate goal of courteous and safe hunting throughout the year, and
- WHEREAS, Congress, by a joint resolution, has suggested that the week including July 4 each year be proclaimed "Safe Bunting Week" throughout the United States,
- AND, WHEREAS, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby designate July 2 through July 8, 1961, as

"SAFE BUNTING WEEK"

in Minnesota and urge all citizens and organizations interested in recreational hunting to observe this week in an effort to make this year the safest in the history of recreational hunting.
