RESOLUTION.

A petition signed by J. A. Diethelm and others having been presented to the County Board, praying for the calling of an election for the determination of the incorporation as a village of certain territory in this County in said petition particularly described to be known as the Village of Victoria; and said matter having been duly presented to this Board on the 16th day of November 1915, and this Board having duly approved said petition.

Now, therefore, It is hereby ordered, that an election for the determination of such proposed incorporation be held within the limits of the proposed village at the building known as the "Fire House" situated on Lot No. 12, of Block No. 2 of Victoria, on the 21st day of December, 1915, from the hour of 9 A.M. to 5 P.M.

And, It is further Ordered. That Math Grausam, Fred Fink and Frank Diethelm, residents of said territory, be, and they hereby are, appointed inspectors to conduct such election in the manner provided by law, and to report the result of such election in the manner provided by law.

And, It is further Ordered, That the County Auditor of this County, give notice of the time and place of holding such election and cause the same to be posted as required by law.

We, the undersigned inspectors duly appointed by the resolution of the County Board of said County on the 16th day of November, 1915, to conduct the election called by said Board for the determination of the proposed incorporation of certain territory in said County as a village to be known as the village of Victoria, hereby certify that, pursuant to the resolution of said County Board and to notice of such election duly given as required by law, an election for the purpose of determining the proposed incorporation of certain territory particularly described in the petition of J. A. Diethelm and others filed in the office of the County Auditor of said County on Oct. 22, 1915, was held on the 21st day of December, 1915, from 9 A. M. to 5 P. M., at the building known as the "Fire House" situated on Lot No. 12 of Block No. 2 of Victoria according to the plat of Victoria filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds for said County, which said building is within the limits of the proposed village; that we conducted such election in the manner provided by law, and voting ^{thereat} ~~thereof~~ was by ballot as prescribed by Sec. 1207, Gen. Stats. of 1913; that we have duly canvassed the ballots cast on such election, and that thereat 40 ballots were cast for said proposition and 3 ballots were cast against said proposition; and that all the persons voting at such election were legal voters residing within the territory proposed to be incorporated.
