ORDINANCE NO. 308

an ordinance entending the corporate limits of the city of aroka TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS ADUTTING THE CITY OF AHORA.

The City Commission of the City of Anoka do ordain:

SECTION I

WHEREAS, the City of Anoka is now the owner of the following described property, to-wit:

> All of Lot Bight (8), Auditor's Subdivision No. 32, Anoka County, Minnesota, save and except the following portion of said Lot Eight (8) described as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest (SH) corner of said Lot Hight (8), thence North on the West line thereof Four Mundred Eighty-five feet (485'), thence East and parallel with the South line of said Lot Eight (8), a distance of Four Hundred Fifteen fact (415'), thence South and parallel with the West line of said Lot Eight (8) a distance of Four Hundred Eighty-five feet (495') to the South line of said Lot Eight (8), thouse West on the South Line of said Lot Eight (8), a distance of Four Hundred Fifteen feet (415') to the place of beginning.

SECTION II

The corporate limits of the City of Anoka are hereby extended to include the property described in Section I and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City of Anolto as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

SECTION III

The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State and the County Auditor.
