A PROCLAMATION FOR "NATIONAL DEFENSE TRANSPORTATION DAY"

WHEREAS, the defense of our nation depends on a strong system of transportation on land, on water and in the air; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota has modern transportation facilities serving a vast area of the heartland of America; and

WHEREAS, the people working in transportation are partners with the members of the Armed Forces in the defense of the nation,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, May 19, 1961, as

NATIONAL DEFENSE TRANSPORTATION DAY

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to join with the rest of the nation in recognizing the contribution of our transportation industry to the defense and development of our country.
